



ORGANIZATION'S CAPACITY BUILDING

• Celebrations with Gond Art' organised by Cognizant



• Adobe Spark Training




MAKING OUR PRESENCE FELT

• Digitization Project


In the Digital Literacy unit, we are part of an initiative Mission1000 by Enable India and DNA, our young adults got a wonderful opportunity to work as proofreader/editor to generate audio books for persons with visual impairment of Saksham Trust. We started working on 15th August, 2020 under the leadership of Ms. Meenakshy Kavassery(Program head, Digitization unit) and took our first step towards livelihood opportunity and independence.





• Aadhar Outreach Program (BGCT-IDFC FIRST Bank collaboration)

Our program took a turn in the 'new normal" under our strategic and funding partner IDFC FIRST Bank. We selected 5 NGOs across Karnataka and West Bengal. We aim to provide capacity building through online sessions for trainers and the organization to run a structured Primary Intervention Program for students upto 10years.
